

2026 PGA TOUR CHAMPIONS CADDIE HEADWEAR PROGRAM RULES & REGULATIONS

MUST WEAR: Official James Hardie logoed headwear each competition and pro-am round. The hat must be one of the official branded hats provided by PGA TOUR Champions. Hats that are produced by the caddies themselves are not eligible.

Caddies who sign up for the Caddie Headwear Program are committed to the Rules & Regulations laid out below for the remainder of the season.

2026 SEASON: Mitsubishi Electric Classic at Hualalai through Charles Schwab Cup Championship including Majors. Caddies must wear James Hardie-logoed headwear in a minimum of **5** events in 2026 to be eligible for the plan.

POINT SYSTEM: 1 point for every competition round
1 point for the pro-am (regardless of whether your pro plays one or two days)

For every 5 events that you wear a James Hardie hat this season, you will earn an additional 10 points.

REGULATIONS:

- If, for any one event, you are offered a different hat from another company to wear for a separate monetary incentive, you will be disqualified from the Caddie Headwear Program and forfeit all points previously earned.
- Caddies may only wear a non-James Hardie hat if it is at the request of your professional (ie. Due to a new sponsorship relationship).
- Caddies must wear the James Hardie hat for all three competition rounds and proam rounds
 - Exception: if your player withdraws, points will be given for number of rounds completed
- Caddies may opt into the Caddie Headwear Program only once at any point in the season.
 - Exception: A caddie may opt back into the program for the season (if they had previously opted out due to their professional's sponsorship relationship) because they have switched players and their new player does not ask them to wear a sponsored hat

POINT VALUE: Determined at end of the season by dividing points earned by all eligible caddies by total pool.

TOTAL POOL: \$500,000

Deadlines for the 2026 James Hardie Hat Program Events Confirmation

1. Caddies that worked 5 or more events and are eligible for the program will receive an email to confirm events by **December 1st, 2026.**

2. It is the Caddies responsibility to reply via email and confirm their event total.
3. If PGA TOUR Champions does not get an emailed confirmation of events from the Caddie by **December 9th, 2026 at 5pm ET**, they will be paid for the events recorded and will not be able to make any adjustments.
4. Any Caddie that believes they qualified for the program (5 or more events) but has not received an email to confirm events by December 1st 2026, please reach out to GabySantini@pgatourhq.com by **December 9th, 2026 @ 5pm ET**. If we do not hear from the Caddie by the deadline stated, PGA TOUR Champions will not award any points or make any adjustments.
