Significant Regulation Updates for 2025

PGA TOUR Champions

<u>Please note: these changes are highlighted in the 2025 PGA TOUR Champions Handbook the full 2025 Handbook can be found on PGA TOUR LINKS under the RULES & REGULATIONS tab.</u>

- Major Medical Exemption Language has been cleared up to simplify and explain the Major Medical Exemption process and exemptions. This category has been added as exempt into Regions Tradition and Kaulig Companies Championship. Details on page 16, 69, 72 of Handbook.
- Golf Cart Policy Please refer to page 84 of Handbook for full details
- The PGA TOUR Champions event in Boca Raton, FL is a Pro/NFL Player event. Professional eligibility is standard eligibility. Friday and Saturday will consist of 26 groups (playing in foursomes. 13 groups will have 2 Pros and 2 NFL players. 13 groups will be all Pros). The format with the Pro Football Hall of Fame participants will be a two man (1 PGA TOUR Champions Professional and 1 NFL player) best ball competition. The NFL player will stay with his Professional for the first and second round. Sunday will be Professionals only.
- Insperity Invitational Top 36 Prior Year Points are now eligible. Medalist from Qualifying Tournament has been removed. The alternate list will alternate between players from PGA TOUR Champions Previous Year's Charles Schwab Cup Points List to a floor of 54 and players from the All-Time Money List to a floor of 100. Details on page 68.
- American Family Insurance Championship TPC Wisconsin will host a Team Event. Two Pro Am Days (Wednesday and Thursday); Official competition days (54-hole competition): Friday (Team Best Ball), Saturday (Team Scramble); Sunday (Team Best Ball), Playoff (Best Ball). 38 teams will compete. 2 players per team. Eligibility explains the list of players eligible to pick a partner and those who are eligible to be picked. Full details on page 71.

2025 Agronomy Report

Golf Course Superintendent: Simon Rees | PGA TOUR Agronomist: PJ Ringenberger

Royal Golf Dar Es Salam, Red Course will host the Trophy Hassan II for the third consecutive year. The turf quality and entirety of the property continue to improve with Simon Rees' desire to provide some of the best golf in Morocco. Thanks to daily routines and a solid agronomic plan, the 007 bentgrass greens are in the best shape they have been since the inception of this event. The Seaside bentgrass tees are in good shape and boast 100% turf coverage. The kikuyugrass fairways are in good shape and during cooler parts of the season are supplemented with spot overseeding. The rough is overseeded, and the uniform stand will provide good color contrast. The bunkers are consistent and will be hand-raked daily.

Quick Facts:

The target greenspeed will be 11 feet.

The tees will be mowed at 8 mm (0.315").

The fairways and approaches will be moved at 10 mm (0.394").

There is no intermediate rough, and the primary rough will be maintained at 60 mm (2.36 inches).

2025 Agronomy Report

Director of Agronomy: Grayson Grainger

The Black Course at Tiburon is in good condition for the Chubb Classic. The TifEagle bermudagrass greens are healthy with full canopies and minimal work needed to achieve tournament conditions. There is a section of new sod on the front right corner of #4 green that remains to be seen if it will be fully established by tournament week. The Zeon zoysiagrass tees are in excellent condition. The GN1 bermudagrass fairways are in good condition despite heavy play levels during the winter season. Rough will be benign for the competition. There have been no major changes on-course since last year's tournament. Nine green-side bunkers were renovated on hole #s 3, 4, 16, 17, 18 and filled with G-Angle sand.

Quick Facts:

The target greenspeed will be 12.5 feet.

The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.275 inch.

The fairways will be mowed at 0.400 inch.

The rough will be maintained at 2 inches. There is no intermediate step-cut on the Black Course.

2025 Agronomy Report

Golf Course Superintendent: Daniel Mayfield | PGA TOUR Agronomist: PJ Ringenberger

The beautiful Jack Nicklaus designed La Paloma golf course will host the front nine on the Ridge course, and the back nine will be a mix of the Hill and Canyons courses. The overseeded bermudagrass greens are healthy and maturing toward a dense and consistent surface. The overseed on all short-grass areas including tees, fairways, and approaches took well on all three sets of nines. The overseeded rough provides good contrast. The bunkers are older but are well managed and provide consistent sand. Winter has been very cold this year with many frosty mornings and no rain since early November. Since last year, many of the native areas along holes' perimeter edges have been cleaned up, resulting in improved aesthetics and increased visibility.

Quick Facts:

The greenspeed will be in the range of 11 - 11.5 feet.

The tees, fairways, and approaches will be mowed at 0.450 inch.

There is no intermediate rough, and the primary rough will be maintained at 2 inches.

Model Local Rule G-9

Starting January 1, 2025

Note: The following Model Local Rule replaces the version of MLR G-9 published in the printed edition of the 'Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, Effective January 2023' starting on 1 January 2025.

G-9 - Broken or Significantly Damaged Club Replaced with Similar Club

Purpose. Rule 4.1a(2) allows a player to repair or replace a club that is damaged during the round, except in cases of abuse. But a Committee may adopt a Local Rule to restrict replacement to cases where the club is broken or significantly damaged. Model Local Rule G-9

"Rule 4.1a(2) applies but is modified in these ways:

1. A club damaged by the player or their caddie during the round or while play is stopped under Rule 5.7a may only be replaced if the damage was not caused by abuse and if the club is broken or the damage is significant.

For the purposes of this Local Rule, examples of when a club is "broken or the damage is significant" include: Shaft:

• The shaft is in pieces, or it is bent, dented, kinked or splintered.

Clubhead (except Club Face):

- The clubhead is visibly cracked or substantially deformed (but not when it is only scratched, chipped or has a minor dent),
- The clubhead is loose or no longer attached to the shaft, or
- A part inside the clubhead is loose (such as when there is an audible rattle).

Club Face

• The club face is visibly cracked or deformed (including when it has a chip or minor dent but not when it is only scratched).

Grip:

- The grip or part of it is loose.
- 2. To ensure the progression of the set is maintained, the replacement club must fill the gap created when the player took the broken or damaged club out of play.

Penalty for Breach of Local Rule - See Rule 4.1b." (Revised January 2025)

Pairings with a Pro - Important Information

As part of Cologuard's Pairings with A Pro initiative, players will once again compete on behalf of a colon cancer patient, survivor, or in memory of someone who has been affected by colorectal cancer. As in previous years at the Cologuard Classic, players will be asked to wear a ribbon with the name of their honoree throughout the competition and learn more about their personal experience with colon cancer. Many of the honorees will be on-site and will have the opportunity to meet their Pro in person.

Important Awareness Details:

- Players will be asked to sign a card and write a message of encouragement for the individual they are playing in honor of.
- Additionally, players will be asked to record a brief 15-30 second video message dedicated to their honoree or their honoree's family.
- The Cologuard team will have three staff members and two cameras on the range pre-tournament to help capture this
 content.

In Memory of Steve DiMeglio

Cologuard is also honoring the memory of Steve DiMeglio, longtime golf writer for USA Today and Golfweek, who passed away in early January following a two-year battle with colorectal cancer. Steve was 63 and a beloved figure in the golf community, having made an impact on players, caddies, and fellow journalists.

The past two years, have seen Steve Stricker (2023) and Billy Andrade (2024) play in honor of DiMeglio, showing their support and encouragement in his fight against colorectal cancer. This year, the tournament will continue to honor Steve's legacy with a special "In Memory of Steve DiMeglio" blue ribbon, similar to the ribbons worn for the Pairings with a Pro program. One player competing at this year's event will represent Steve in remembrance. His story and impact will be highlighted across PGA TOUR Champions channels and by his friends in the media. We encourage any players who were impacted by Steve to show their support during tournament week as well, in addition to the support of your designated honoree.
