## 2025 Agronomy Report

Director of Golf Course Maintenance Operations: Kyle Worthy | PGA TOUR Agronomist: Alex J. Stuedemann, CGCS

The Stables and Meadows courses at TPC Sugarloaf are well positioned to produce similar tournament conditions as previous years. Proactive agronomic processes on the TifEagle bermudagrass greens, Zeon zoysiagrass closely mown areas, and mixed bermudagrass/zoysiagrass primary rough have sustained the surfaces through the winter months. All species are currently breaking dormancy. The intensity of agronomic practices to achieve tournament targets will be determined by the arrival of warmer temperatures and turfgrass growth potential. There have been no changes to the course since last year.

Quick Facts:

The target greenspeed will be 12+'.

The tees, fairways, and approaches will be mowed at 0.400".

There is no intermediate rough, and the primary rough will be maintained at 2.25".

## 2025 Agronomy Report

The Woodlands Tournament Course came through the winter in good condition. The bermudagrass is gradually improving as winter fades and spring weather prevails. The bermudagrass tees, fairways, and rough are all in good shape and consistent with prior years. As previously witnessed, the MiniVerde greens are in good condition but are visibly contaminated with off-type bermudagrass. Cultural practices are in place to minimize the impact of the off-type bermuda on ball roll to provide the smoothest and most consistent greenspeeds as possible. The Better Billy Bunkers with Arkansas white sand are in great shape. The only course changes are the loss of several trees due to Hurricane Beryl.

The tees, fairways, and approaches will be mowed at 0.400".

The intermediate rough will be maintained at 0.750", and the primary rough at 2.0"

The Founders Course at Greystone Golf & Country Club is well positioned coming out of winter to host the Regions Tradition in May. The Champion bermudagrass greens are expected to roll smooth and true with only minor off-type contamination mainly along collars. The bermudagrass tees, approaches, and fairways will perform similarly to past years after receiving early spring fertility to bolster growth. The bermudagrass rough is expected to be relatively benign as spring temperatures slowly increase and push growth accordingly. Some spot sodding occurs each year, mainly along the cart path side of the rough, where shade and traffic limit growth potential.

Quick Facts:

The target greenspeed will be in the range of 12.5 - 13.

The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.410".

The fairways will be moved at 0.450".

The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1.0", and the primary rough will be maintained at 2.0".
