

## 2025 Agronomy Report

Golf Course Superintendent: Dane Wilson

PGA TOUR Agronomist: Mike Crawford, CGCS

Wakonda Club has come through the winter in good agronomic condition and is well-positioned to provide quality playing conditions for the upcoming tournament. The A1/A4 bentgrass putting greens are in good condition and are expected to provide smooth, true putting conditions. The bentgrass, ryegrass, Poa annua tees, approaches, and fairways possess complete turf coverage with solid density and are expected to play similarly to previous years. The cool-season blend of turf in the rough will be maintained near 3 inches. Cart path additions have been installed at holes 1,12, and 18, and no other changes have been made to the golf course since last year's competition.

#### **Quick Facts:**

The target greenspeed will be 11' - 11.5'

The tees, fairways, and approaches will be mowed at 0.425 inch.

The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1.25 inches, and the primary rough will be maintained near 3 inches.

## 2025 Agronomy Report

This year's venue, the newly renovated TPC Wisconsin, has weathered through the winter months despite variable snow cover and bouts of extremely cold temperatures. The almost 3-year-old creeping bentgrass putting surfaces are densely covered and well-positioned for final tournament preparations. The remaining creeping bentgrass closely mown areas benefit from a sandy soil profile that, with favorable weather, is expected to provide firm conditions. Warming spring temperatures should allow the narrow bands of Kentucky bluegrass primary rough to buffer the many wetland areas that closely border the playing corridors.

#### **Quick Facts:**

The target greenspeed will be 11.5 - 12'.

The tees and approaches will be moved between 0.325 - 0.375".

The fairways will be moved between 0.400 - 0.425".

The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1", and the primary rough will be maintained at 3".
