From the desk of Miller Brady - I'm pleased to inform you that PGA TOUR Champions has announced a new event set to debut in 2026. The Portugal Invitational, in partnership with Arrow Global Group, Turismo de Portugal and Turismo de Algarve, will announce a five-year partnership to host the Portugal Invitational at The Els Club Vilamoura in Algarve, Portugal, with World Golf Hall of Fame member Ernie Els serving as official course designer and tournament host. The event – to be held July 31-August 2, 2026, the week after the ISPS Handa Senior Open – will mark the first PGA TOUR-sanctioned individual stroke play event to be held in Portugal and will feature a purse of \$3 million USD

Tournament Update

The Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS presented by Circle K announced that it will relocate to the Ocean Course at Hammock Beach Golf Resort & Spa in Palm Coast, Florida beginning in 2026 under a new multi-year agreement. The 2026 tournament will retain its traditional timeframe on the PGA TOUR Champions schedule. A Jack Nicklaus Signature Design, the award-winning Ocean Course features six holes overlooking the Atlantic Ocean - the most of any course in Florida. The venue has previously hosted the Ginn Championship (PGA TOUR Champions, 2007–2008) and the Ginn sur Mer Classic (PGA TOUR, 2008). This year's Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS returns to Timuquana Country Club in Jacksonville, Florida for the final year Sept. 29 – Oct. 5, 2025.

The Club at Snoqualmie Ridge is in good condition and is expected to provide another year of quality playing conditions for the competition. The staff is presently completing the final agronomic tournament preparations. The Poa annua greens have full and consistent turf coverage and should have no problem reaching the target greenspeed. All fairway lines and collection areas around the greens are in the same location as last year. No course changes have been made to the golf course since last year's event.

Quick Facts:

The target greenspeed will be in the range of 12 - 12.5'.

The tees, fairways, and approaches will be mowed at 0.380 - 0.390 inch.

The primary rough will be maintained at 2 inches.

Canyon Meadows Golf and Country Club has emerged from winter and spring in good shape. As is typical, the dry climate continues into the summer months. The bentgrass greens continue to improve as Poa annua is being slowly and strategically removed from the surfaces to allow for a more pure stand of bentgrass. The greens are in great shape with good density and texture. The Poa annua/bentgrass fairways, approaches, and tees all boast 100% turf coverage and provide great surfaces for competition. All approaches and collars on the back nine were replaced last year with low-mow bluegrass and look very good. The bluegrass rough is in good condition.

Quick Facts:

The target greenspeed will be in the range of 12 - 13'.

The tees, fairways, and approaches will be moved at 0.350 - 0.400 inch.

The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1 inch, and the primary rough will be maintained at 3 - 3.5

Warwick Hills Golf and Country Club is in very good condition and is well-positioned to provide excellent playing conditions for the upcoming tournament. The bentgrass/Poa annua putting greens are densely covered and are expected to provide smooth and true putting surfaces. The cool-season tees, fairways, and approaches are densely covered and in very good condition. The non-irrigated cool-season rough is in good shape; however, if a pattern of extended heat or drought develops leading into the event, the rough could become less dense and somewhat inconsistent where it does not receive supplemental irrigation. Select trees have been removed and/or trimmed throughout the course to improve sunlight for turfgrass growth and health. No other changes have been made to the golf course since last year's event.

Quick Facts:

The target greenspeed will be near 12 feet.

The tees and approaches will be moved at 0.375 inch, and the fairways will be moved at 0.400 inch.

The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1 inch, and the primary rough will be maintained at 2.5 inches.
