

## **PGA TOUR CHAMPIONS CADDIE REGULATIONS**

All players in PGA TOUR Champions events shall employ caddies for all pro-am rounds and tournament rounds. Caddies shall be paid promptly. PGA TOUR Champions shall determine who is eligible to be employed as a caddie. Players who bring their own caddies to a PGA TOUR Champions cosponsored event shall be responsible for the conduct and behavior of their caddies at such events.

1. Caddies must complete the Caddie Registration Form.
2. Caddies are required to wear uniforms/bibs and photo identification badges as prescribed by the host tournament and PGA TOUR Champions. All caddies are required to wear solid-colored khaki-style long pants, which touch the top of the shoe, or solid colored, knee-length tailored shorts or skorts, and a collared shirt while on club property. In addition, shirts must be tucked in and hats facing forward. T-shirts, jeans, culottes, skirts, capris, cut-off shorts and cargo style shorts are not permitted. Acceptable colors shall be determined at the discretion of the Rules Official Tournament Director.
3. Caddies must carry their player's clubs. Push or pull carts or the like are not permitted.
4. Caddies may wear clothing or headwear provided in connection with a (their) player's endorsement contract.
5. Caddies must conform to the Player Endorsement Policy.
6. PGA TOUR has the right to reject multi-caddie endorsement arrangements.
7. Caddies shall wear smooth rubber shoes. Golf Spikes, opened-toe shoes or flip flops are prohibited.
8. Caddies, when unaccompanied by their player, may walk and roll balls on the putting greens during practice round days, so long as play is not disrupted. Caddies may not walk on putting greens on any day, at any time, after a Pro-Am or before and after official tournament rounds.
9. Caddies may not walk across or stand on the putting green unnecessarily. The use of permanent markers, paint or other similar products to create lines on the practice putting and chipping greens is not permitted. If marks or lines are created on these surfaces, they must be done with a non-permanent material, such as a chalk line, which will not damage the turf and will disappear in a short period of time.
10. Caddies are not allowed in the locker room at any time. They can be escorted in to retrieve an item from players locker. Caddies are not allowed in the locker room at any other time. Caddies shall not enter the clubhouse or on-site hospitality tents, unless caddie is a family member or receives the approval of a PGA TOUR Champions Rules Official. Caddies may enter the locker

room to retrieve items after the conclusion of the final round.

11. Caddies shall assist in maintaining the course by replacing divots and raking bunkers.

12. Caddies shall not hit shots or putts anywhere on the practice area or course, except in specifically approved competitions.

13. Caddies shall assume the risk of physical injury and waive any claim, from injury or otherwise, resulting from participation in the Tournament. Further, caddies agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless, PGA TOUR, the Tournament host organization, and the Tournament title sponsor and other sponsors from any and all liability occurring as a result of participation in the Tournament.

14. Caddies shall not falsely register for accommodations, or leave unpaid bills.

15. Caddies shall not engage in any conduct which is prohibited for players under the PGA TOUR Anti-Doping Program.

16. Caddies shall not engage in conduct unbecoming a professional caddie on PGA TOUR Champions, as determined in the sole discretion of PGA TOUR Champions.

17. Caddies shall not engage in any conduct that is prohibited under the PGA TOUR Integrity Program.

18. Caddies may not capture or distribute any video, audio, or photograph on site at a tournament throughout tournament week (including on practice days) without the written permission of the PGA TOUR. Personal information collected from you will be used by PGA TOUR for the purpose of administering the tournaments on the tours operated and/or sanctioned by PGA TOUR and providing you with information relating to products, services, news and promotions of PGA TOUR and affiliates of PGA TOUR. PGA TOUR shall not sell, share or otherwise disclose your personal information of applicants with third parties, other than to third parties engaged by PGA TOUR to fulfill the above purposes or as otherwise consented to by the applicant. A caddie who does not comply with these Caddie Regulations will be subject to losing the privilege to caddie on PGA TOUR Champions. Also, for any violation of these regulations which affect play, a fine will be levied against the caddie's player
